Cariño reported that the Task Force attended an all-day work group on *Exploring Effective Practices for Justice-Involved Women* in April. Priority topics were housing, diversion (alternatives to incarceration), and gender-responsive training.

McPherson represented the Women's Commission at a community partner meeting in April addressing the issue of homelessness in Santa Cruz County. Staff will follow-up on meeting materials presented.
